This company is in breach of trademark infringement and intellectual property use and has nothing whatsoever to do with the late Ian Farrier, Farrier Marine, Farrier International, F-boat.com, or any other company owned by Daedalus Yachts.

The website shows a clearly doctored image which is poorly produced and date stamped from more than two years ago, that makes it clear to even an untrained eye they are fraudulently portraying this image as work in progress.

This company is attempting to continue trading off the late Ian Farrier's reputation and the illegal use of his designs.

We will not be commenting on this issue other than this release, due to pending legal action.
